Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Students will fill out the following surveys: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Department of Education – Condition of Learning Survey Bright Bytes Technology Survey Students will be informed of the 3rd Trimester Testing Schedule and laptop check-in procedures for the end of the year
Materials Needed:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will need their laptops for the surveys Teachers will need a laptop and LCD projector
Suggested Process:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Before you start the activity, ask your students to share any pieces of good news they have (something good that's happened to them since your last meeting – from school, personal lives, extracurriculars, etc.). Not everyone has to share, but give kids a chance to do this. You can model this by sharing a piece of good news that you have. Have students open up their laptops to take the surveys: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The first survey link is the Dept. of Ed. "Conditions of Learning" Survey located at: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2709_0109 (IT MIGHT BE EASIER TO CUT AND PASTE THIS INTO AN EMAIL TO YOUR SEMINAR KIDS) Before students start, inform them of the purpose of the survey and make the following points: <p>The Department of Education conducts surveys every three years for students in grades 5-12 to assess students' levels of comfort and safety in school.</p> <p>This year, students in grades 5-12 throughout the state of Iowa are going to be completing this survey.</p> <p>The survey will be making a series of statements and you need to determine whether or not you agree or disagree with the statement as it pertains to our school.</p> <p>Your answers should reflect your own personal experiences, not what you've "heard" and they are confidential.</p> <p>Make sure you read the directions for each section before you start responding to the statements and do not allow students to talk during the survey or have conversations amongst themselves.</p> Once the students have completed this survey, they have one more to complete located here: https://questionnaire.bbyt.es/campaigns/55c535bfbee927544dd76cd5 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (IT MIGHT BE EASIER TO CUT AND PASTE THIS INTO AN EMAIL TO YOUR SEMINAR KIDS)
