Grade Level: 10th	Career Exploration and Works Values
Recommended Sequence	Seminar Meeting
Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):	 Identify skills they'd like to use in their future careers. Identify what work values are important to them and the careers they are interested in. Assess which type of career is best suited for their interests and goals.
Materials Needed:	ProjectorXello Powerpoint
Suggested Process:	 Ask students what is going well, what when well last trimester, what have they learned since coming to high school. Asking students what are their career goals, do these goals involve college, tech trades, diplomas or something else? Walk students through the powerpoint presentation for direction on how to work Xello. Discuss with students as they work through this, they might have questions regarding vocab. Walk around and look at the matches that students get, are they a good match why or why not. Talk with students about how their work values descriptions align with the students interests and values. After everyone has saved at least 3 careers, ask them to discuss in small groups or as a group these questions. Why do you think these are the top identified values? Which of your values appeared in your career matches? How do they relate to values within that career?
