Hello Junior & Senior Seminar Leaders

Tomorrow we are going to be trying something a little different with our junior and senior students. We will be holding mini sessions that include college/career readiness information. Students have been asked to sign up for their session prior to tomorrow and most have.

We will have 5 different sessions for them to choose from. We will have Careers (Key Coop & Alliant Energy) to talk about opportunities right out of high school. We will 2 separate sessions with representatives from lowa and lowa Valley Grinnell to talk about 2 year and 4-year options. We rounded out the sessions by having an SSG from the Amry/National Guard and a panel of 1st Generation college students from Grinnell College students join us.

If students choose to listen to the career presentation they will stay in that location for the entire 40 minutes, if they choose college/military or 1st Gen they will be able to choose 2 sessions to attend. Students might need a reminder once again about that.

What we are asking from you for tomorrow is that we get students moving to their 1st sessions as quickly as possible. The timeline will look something like this:

All students start in regular seminar classes: attendance taken (3 minutes) send students on to 1st session that will start at 10:35. We will switch sessions at 10:48 to do the second session for students unless they are in the career presentation.

If you have a presenter in your classroom can you please stay there to supervise and signal to switch and if you don't have a presenter in your classroom please float around and help students quickly to their next sessions. We should have enough room for everyone and if it gets too full it's okay for them to pick another session.
