Objective(s) / Learning Target(s):	<ul> <li>How can I get work-related experiences while I am still in school?</li> <li>What classes do I need in order to get the experience I want?</li> </ul>

Suggested Process:	<ol> <li>Before you start the activity, ask your students to share any pieces of good news they have (something good that's happened to them since your last meeting – from school, personal lives, extra-curriculars, etc.). Not everyone has to share, but give kids a chance to do this.
